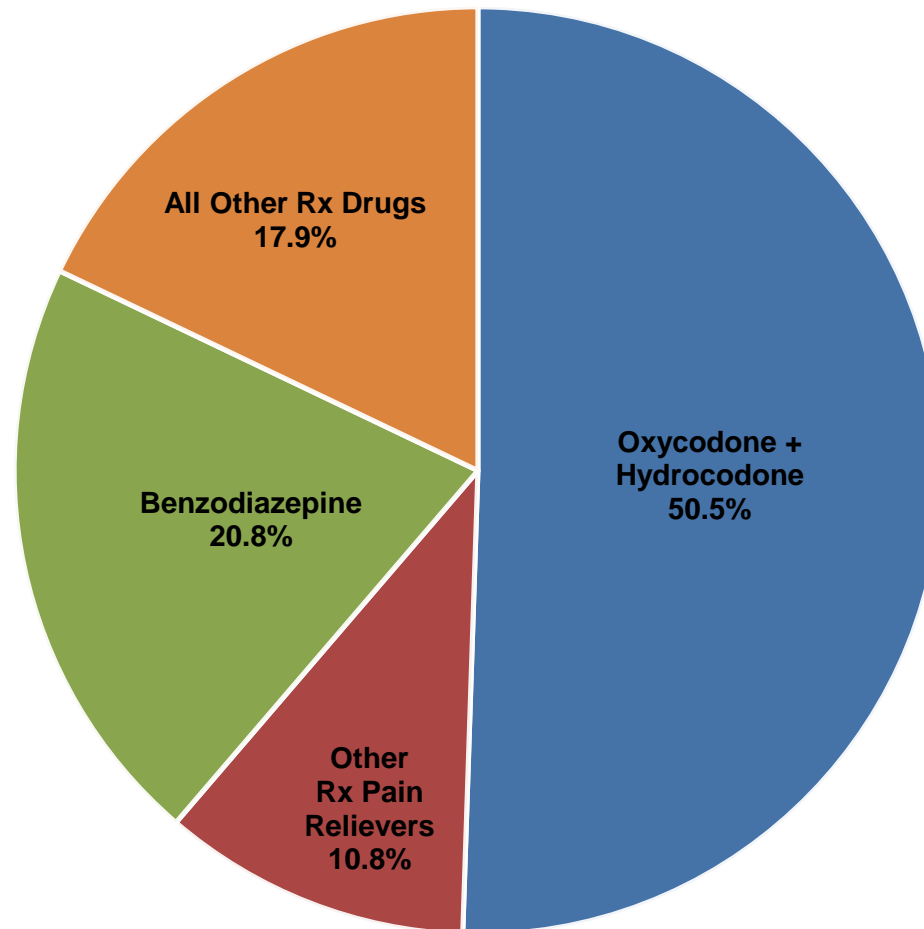


PINAL COUNTY

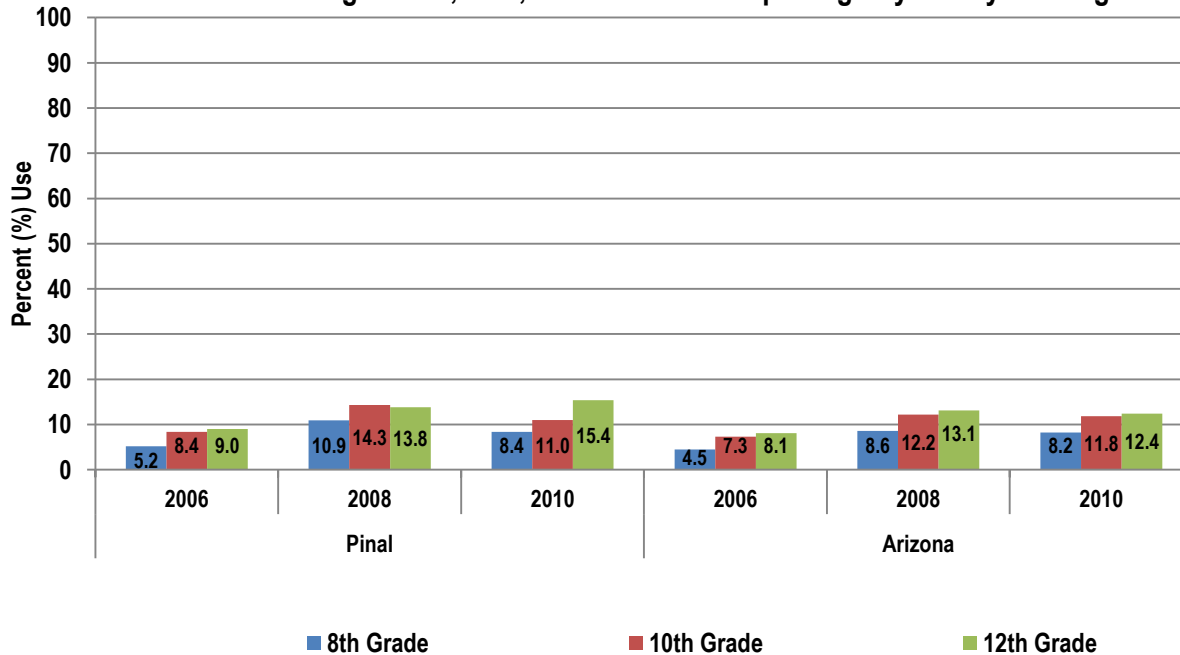
Enough doses of prescription pain relievers were prescribed in 2011 to medicate every Pinal adult around-the-clock for two weeks.

Percentage of Pills by Drug Type in Pinal County (2011)



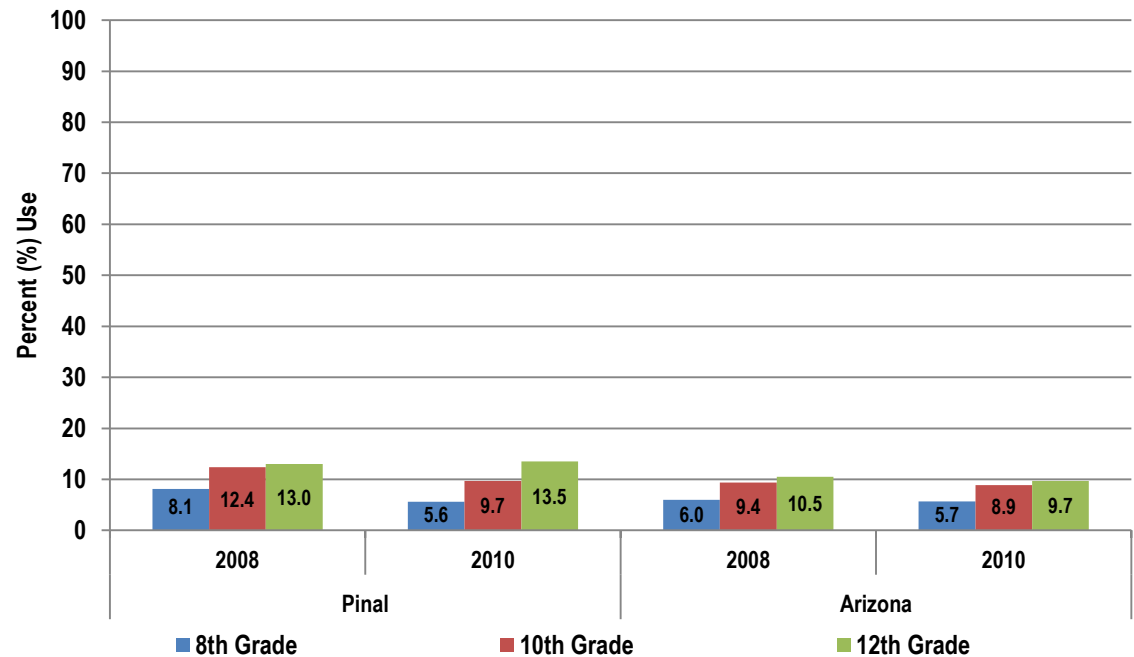
- Over half the pills prescribed in Pinal County in 2011 were either Oxycodone or Hydrocodone
- Rx pain relievers accounted for 61.3% of all pills prescribed in Pinal County in 2011

Percentage of 8th, 10th, & 12th Graders Reporting Any 30 Day Rx Drug Use



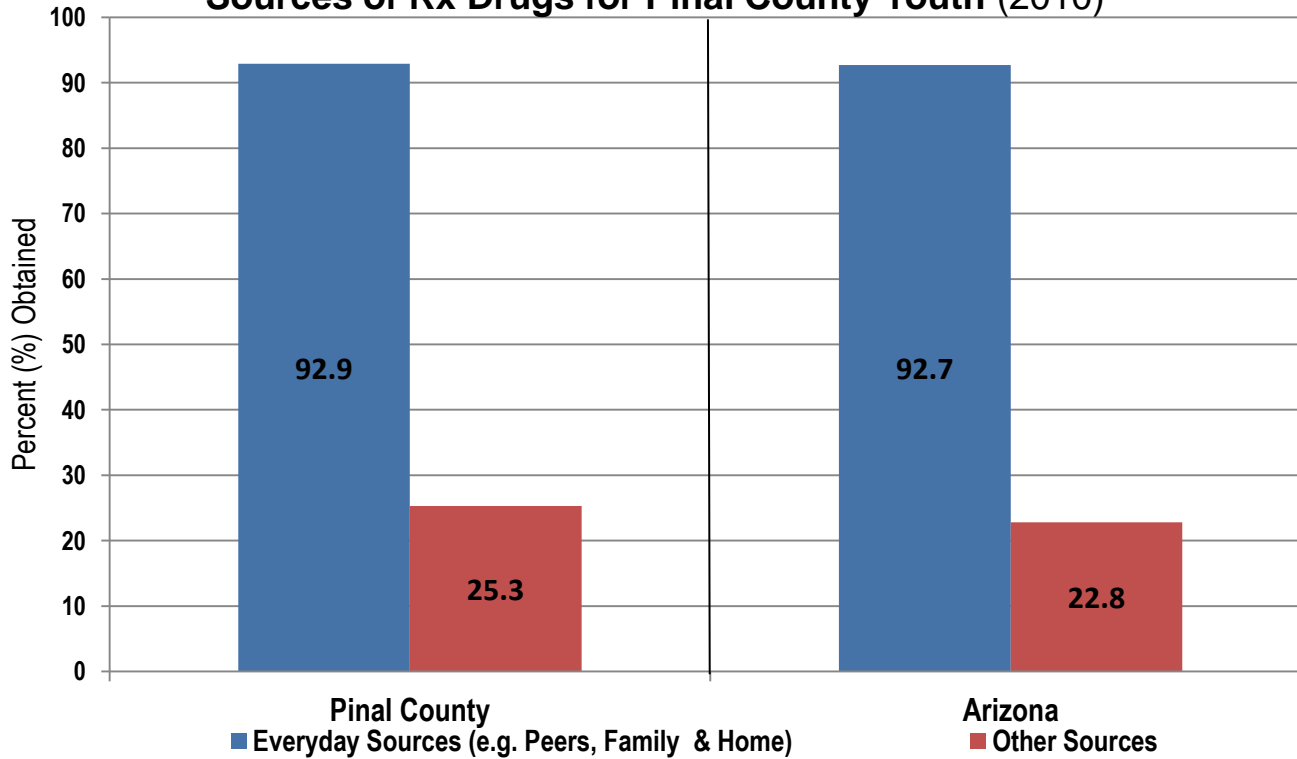
- Both 8th and 12th grade youth in Pinal County had higher rates of Rx drug misuse compared to youth at the State level (2010).
- In 2010:
 - ~1 in 6 12th Graders reported current use
 - ~1 in 9 10th Graders reported current use
 - ~ 1 in 12 8th Graders reported current use

Percentage of 8th, 10th, & 12th Graders Reporting 30 Day Pain Reliever Use



- Both 10th and 12th grade youth in Pinal County had higher rates of Rx pain reliever misuse compare to youth at the State level (2010).
- In 2010:
 - ~1 in 7 12th Graders reported current use
 - ~1 in 10 10th Graders reported current use
 - ~ 1 in 18 8th Graders

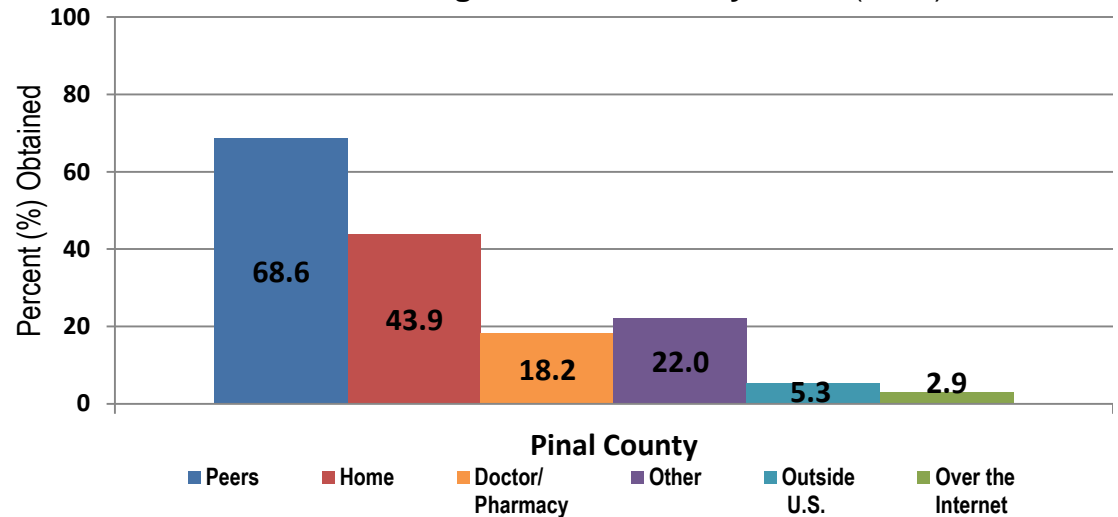
Sources of Rx Drugs for Pinal County Youth (2010)



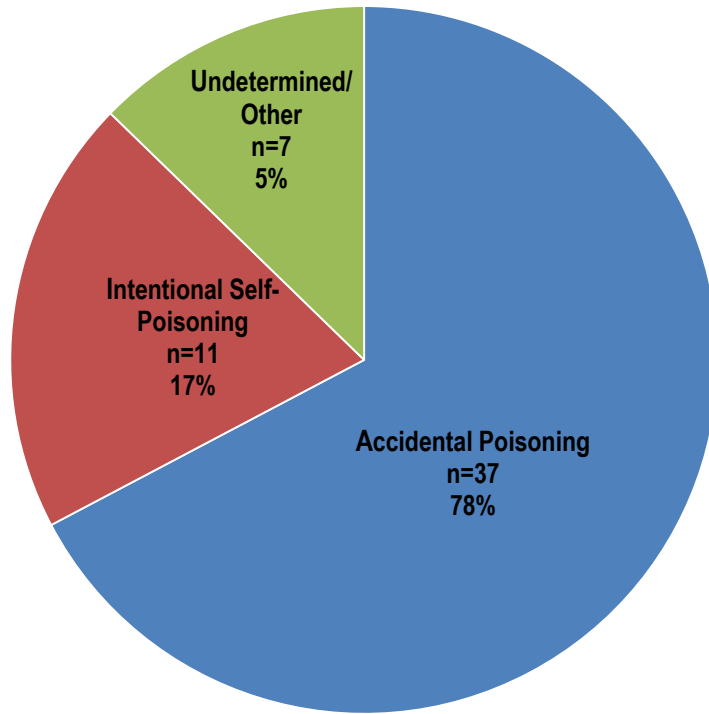
- In 2010, nearly 93% of Pinal County youth obtained the Rx drugs they misused from everyday sources, such as friends, family, or household. This percentage is slightly higher than the state average of 92.7%

- In 2010, peers were the most common sources for the Rx drugs that Pinal County youth misused.

Circumstances of Pinal County Deaths w/Rx Drugs as a Contributing Factor (2010)



- In 2010, 55 deaths in Pinal County involved Rx drugs as a contributing factor.
- The majority of deaths involving Rx drugs as a contributing factor (78%) in Pinal County were classified as accidental poisonings

Pinal County Deaths w/Rx Narcotics as a Contributing Factor

- Opioids were the most common drug listed on deaths certificates for deaths involving Rx narcotics (47.4% and 57.9% for 2009 and 2010, respectively).
